

Diploma in Hotel Management

The Diploma in Hotel Management is clearly orientated to the formation of directors and managers, without overlooking the technical and practical knowledge necessary in the hospitality sector. Theory and practice are continuously alternated, thus constituting a highly integrated and pluri-disciplinary study programme, to prepare future directors in the hotel and catering business.

This Diploma is a study programme designed and accredited by UAB. Students have the opportunity of specialising in one of two branches, through the choice of optional courses. These branches are:

- Hospitality
- Catering



Career opportunities

In general, graduates are prepared for undertaking hotel and restaurant management at the level of general or departmental directors. Posts that they are qualified to hold include:

- Directors of hotels
- Departmental directors in hotel companies
- Directors of catering companies or catering activities which are either independent or linked to hotels
- Directors of the hospitality or catering division of tourist resorts
- Directors of other forms of accommodation (hospitals, residences, etc.)
- General or departmental directors of holiday villages, and apartment complexes
- Hotel project consultants



Entrance requirements

Admittance to the Hotel Management Diploma programme can be acquired with any of the following prior qualifications:

- Spanish COU (A-levels or High School Graduation)
- Spanish Formación Profesional 2
- Spanish Ciclo formativo de grado superior
- Spanish mature student entrance examination (over 25 years)
- Equivalent studies in a foreign educational system
