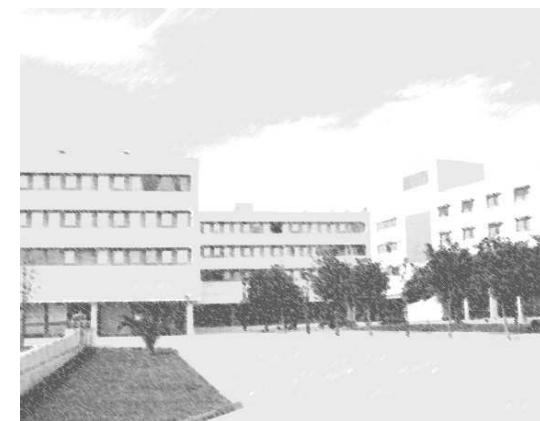

OBJECTIVES

From the 2007-2008 academic year onwards, the UAB, through the *Escola Universitària de Turisme i Direcció Hotelera* (EUTDH) and the *Escola de Prevenció i Seguretat Integral* (EPSI) will be offering its students the chance to obtain two of the qualifications currently on offer at the schools - the Official Diploma in Tourism (DT) and the UAB Diploma in Prevention and Integral Safety (GPSI) - respectively after five years of study.

Once again, EUTDH is providing groundbreaking educational possibilities which make the most of positive synergy and existing institutional collaboration based on the unique features of the DT and GPSI. It also acknowledges the industry's new needs and professional profiles in relation to safety while providing specialised education in integral safety for tourism. On completion of the DT, EUTDH students who wish to gain a broader outlook of safety-related legislation and law for the safety of tourism destinations companies and facilities, may obtain the GPSI by taking a number of complementary modules. Likewise, GPSI graduates who wish to further their education by specialising in the tourism

industry may take the DT. EUTDH Hospitality Management graduates may also participate in this scheme.

The system consists of validating credits from related subjects and taking others that are representative of the remaining professional skills from one course to another, with a view to acquiring qualifications from two university centres of acknowledged quality, which are reference points in their respective educational fields.
